Currently there are almost 1 in 20 people in Eastern Cheshire with diabetes and the number is growing all the time.

Improving diabetes care is one of NHS Eastern Cheshire CCG's priorities and there is an opportunity to integrate specialist services, to support the Caring Together Integrated Care Model

Integrated Diabetes Care has been co-designed as an outcome based model of care with people who have diabetes, colleagues and partners from the NHS, Local Authority/Public Health and Third Sector organisations with an interest in diabetes



We want to be ambitious in what we are aspiring to achieve, and integrated care in Eastern Cheshire needs to:

- Empower people to manage their health more effectively
- Provide outstanding care, which is community based, where possible
- Reduce avoidable appointments and hospital admissions
- Address people's physical and mental health needs to ensure parity of esteem

To ensure that our vision for Integrated Diabetes Care is truly realised, providers and suppliers are encouraged to work innovatively and collaboratively from the outset, to ensure that care is joined up, focused on improving outcomes for adults who are at risk of diabetes or who have a diagnosis of Type 1 or Type 2 diabetes and enabled through technology

NHS Eastern Cheshire CCG is therefore looking for partners (both current and potential providers and suppliers from all backgrounds) who are interested in continuing the co-design work with the focus being empowerment of people to take responsibility for their own health and wellbeing

The specification for Integrated Diabetes Care, including STOPandGO, includes:

- Specialist diabetes services
- Education programs for people with Type 1 and Type 2 diabetes both newly diagnosed and established diabetes
- Technology Enabled Care – including STOPandGO
